The rising cost of living, through increasing energy, food and fuel costs, is affecting many of us.

At Battle Hill Primary School, we are committed to supporting our community, especially those most affected.

North Tyneside Council have a number of ways to support families who have experienced crisis, including fuel grants and food partnerships. This includes help for families and individuals, **whether you're working or not**.

The rising cost of living, and the support to help to deal with it, is changing quickly. We will regularly review support that is available and share with our community as soon as we are aware of anything that can help.

As I mentioned in my previous message, the pop-up shop will open on Friday at the Church of the Good Shepherd.

I currently have 40 discount vouchers. Each voucher gives one week shop/ second week half price shop and can be redeemed at any of the Food Partnerships across North Tyneside, including the pop-up shop on Friday. Because the number of vouchers are limited, they will be allocated on need initially (this is not dependant on income or employment as we are aware any of us can have crisis that affects our day to day lives), then first come, first served basis. However, if I have a greater response than allocated vouchers, I will request additional vouchers from the council.
