Activities for school-aged children in North Tyneside during the school holidays are easier than ever to book as you can now book online!

Activities are funded for children on income-based free school meals, with some paid-for spaces available.





Follow these simple steps to register for an account and manage your bookings online:

- 1.Go to easeinto.northtyneside.gov.uk (or scan the QR code) and click on the 'sign in' option
- 2. You will be given the option to sign in with a Microsoft Account or a Google Account
- 3. Once you've entered your details, you will be asked to enter relevant information for your account
- 4. When you've entered this, you can then create a profile for each child, or dependent - just go to 'manage dependents' and click 'create'
- 5. Here you will be asked to enter your child's details please double check everything before submitting!
- 6. If your child is eligible for income-based free school meals, you will be able to book funded activities, if your child isn't eligible, you will be able to find activities you can pay for
- 7.Go to 'search for activities' to find a all of the fun activities available in the holidays!
- 8. When you've found an activity you want to book, click on 'further information and register', scroll down and click 'register' next to the name of the child you want to book a space for
- 9. If you decide you want to cancel your booking, click on 'my activities' and click 'cancel' next to your child's name under 'activity information'

FAQs:

Why do I need to enter my Microsoft or Google account details?



North Tyneside Council uses Microsoft/Google accounts for authentication, to sign into the system. We will never have access to your log in details.

What does North Tyneside Council do with my data?

Information is shared with:

- The activity provider so they can meet your child's needs and contact you in an emergency
- The Department for Education, who fund this programme

Why are activities only funded for children on income-based free school meals?

Activities are funded by the Holiday Activity and Food programme, via the Department for Education. The funding is ring-fenced to secure spaces for children on income-based free school meals. However, there are activities available that parents and carers can pay for if their children are not eligible.

How do I pay for an activity?

If your child isn't eligible for a funded space, you can book the activity online, but you will then need to contact the activity provider directly to pay. Details will be sent to you via email.
